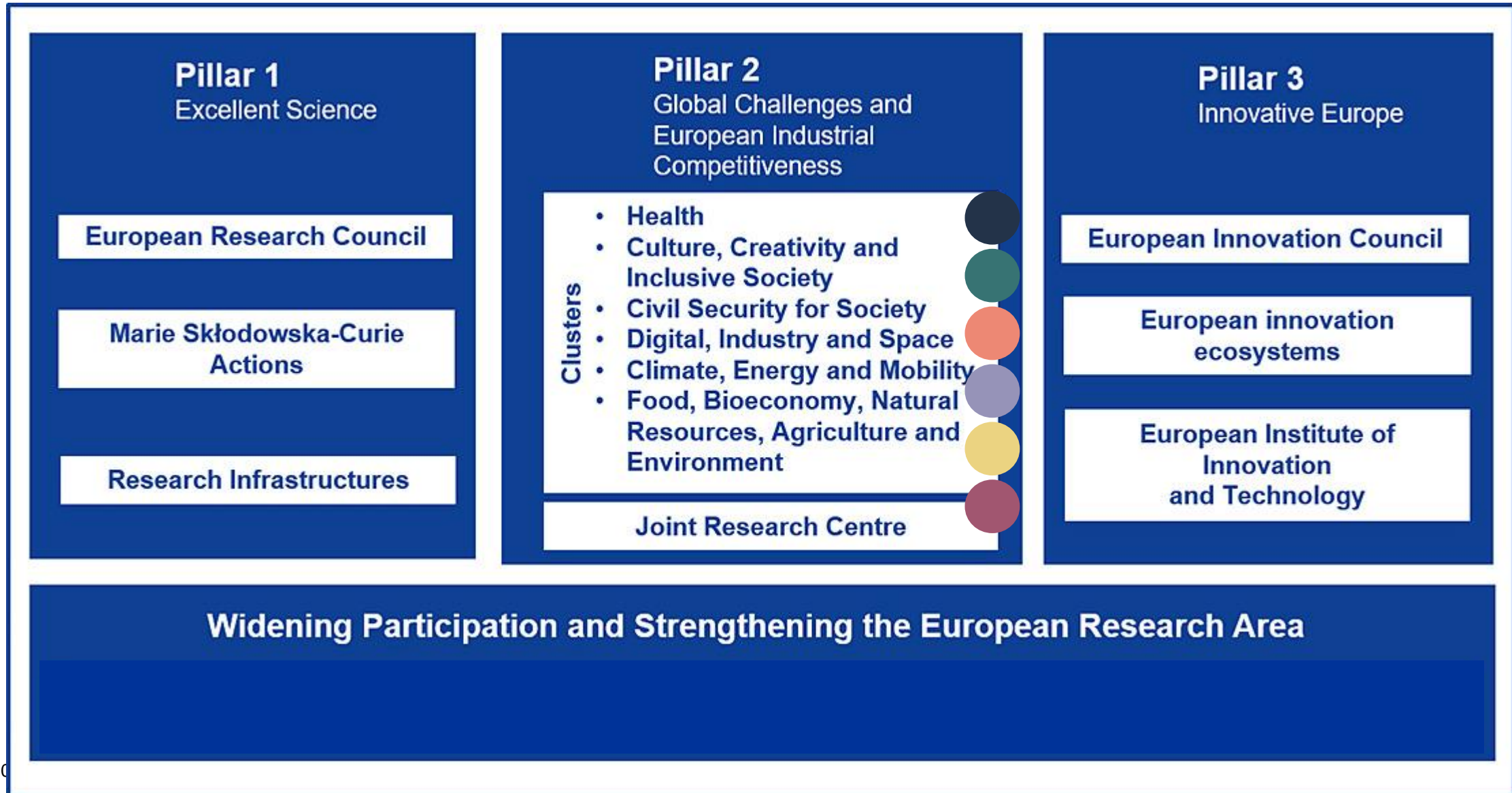


Horizon Europe 2021-2027

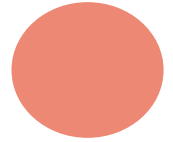

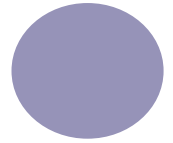

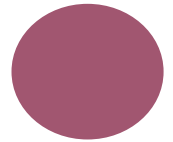

- ~100bn EUR for 2021-2027
- worlds largest research and innovation funding programme

- Technology readiness level is key (TRL 1-8, of 9)
- Topdown vs bottom up
- Monobeneficiary vs collaborative projects

- A participating country may be a EU Member State, Associated country (AC) or third country.
 - ➔ CH aims becoming Associated country (EUR)
 - ➔ CH as third country (CHF)
